



WATER FACILITIES:
Water works owned by Village. Water is taken from Kiamochie Lake 2 miles N.E. of Monticello, which is supplied by mountain streams and springs. The source of supply has never been exhausted. Water is pumped by 2 steam pumps with a capacity of 600 gals. each per minute to a 200,000 gal. storage tank 100 feet high and located 60 feet above the highest point of the town. It is supplied by gravity and direct pumping. Hydraulic pressure 60 lbs. per square inch. Fire pressure 125 to 200 lbs. per square inch. Daily consumption is 100,000 gal. in winter and 80,000 gal. in summer. System was installed in 1895, 18 inches of pipe, 70 hydrants. Water is strained at mouth of intake.

FIRE DEPT.
Horseless, 3 companies, 100 men, no horses, no engines. One R and L truck. One hose wagon and 3 hose reels, 2000 of 2 1/2 inch hose and 2000 of 2 1/2 inch hose in steam. Water is drawn by gravity or by direct pumping. Fire station and alarm is sent to fire station where location of fire is given by ringing bell. The village is divided into 43 fire districts, numbered from 1 to 43 consecutively. Grades as shown. Streets are macadamized and gravelled. Lights elec.
