



he Innisfree facility is as diverse as it is scenic. Situated near the center of the Upper Delaware corridor, designated by Congress as a "wild and scenic river,"

Innisfree and adjacent land is privately owned. However, National Park Service rangers and volunteer river patrols help ensure a safe and enjoyable river experience for all visitors.

Overlooking the river valley near the popular Skinners Falls rapids, Innisfree can sleep about 45 adults between the months of April and October. Combined off-season capacity of the bed & breakfast "main lodge" and hillside cottage is limited to eight.

We specialize in hosting group retreats, with meal service on a flexible schedule. The dormitory building offers hot showers and economical bunk-style lodging.

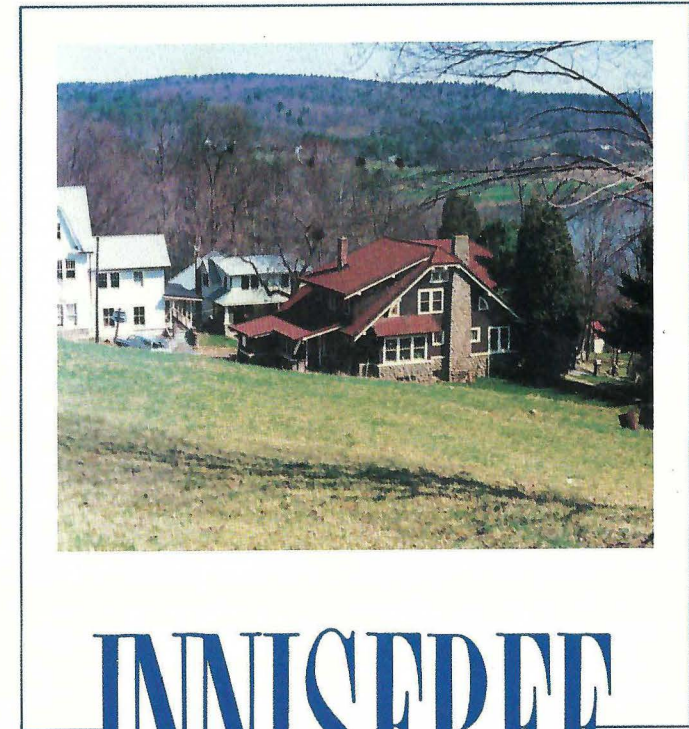

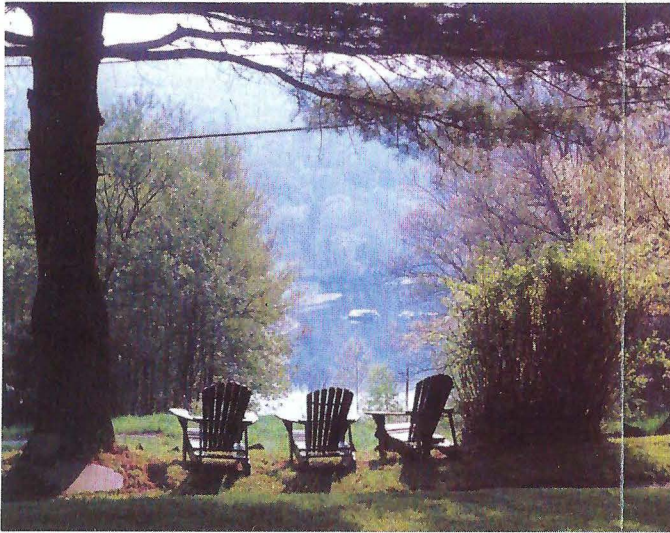

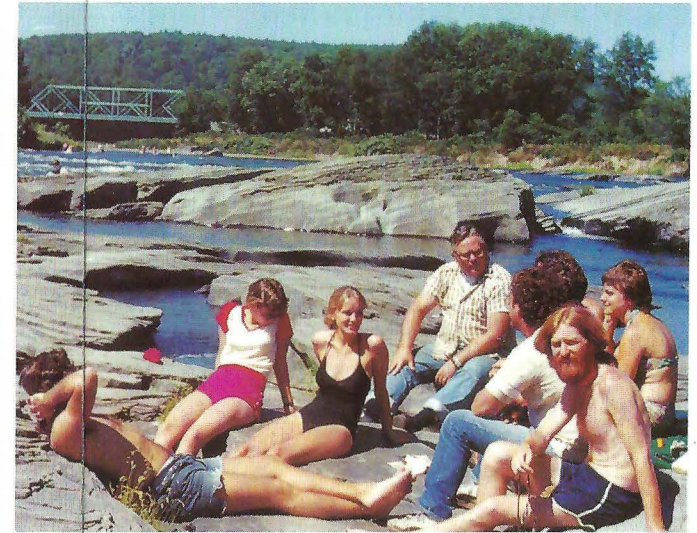

The Upper Delaware National Scenic & Recreational River beckons the recreationist.



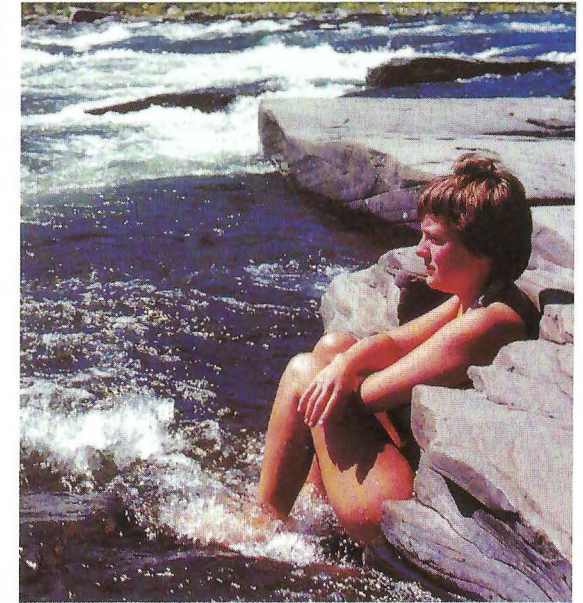
Enjoy the popular Skinners Falls rapids in a canoe, inertube, or by sunning yourself on a rock.
