Statement of Significance:

The Millanville-Skinners Falls
Bridge is an intact example of
multiple span Baltimore truss
of moderate length. It was
built in 1904. It is one of
only three representative
examples of this type of truss
bridges included in this
nomination. It is also unusual
in its location. Most
exemplary truss bridges
included in this nomination
were built in the north
central, northwestern and
southwestern sections of the
state.

Area of Significance:

Engineering. Criteria C.

Boundary Description:

The nominated property consists
of a 500 feet long by 30 feet
wide rectangle, whose vertices
coincide with the outside
corners of the bridge's wing
walls, and includes only bridge
superstructure and
substructure.





