ROUTE: Meet at the Narrowsburg Union, 7 Erie Avenue, Narrowsburg, NY 12764. Register. Map through Narrowsburg Flats will be provided. Follow a marked 5-mile loop and return to the Union for refreshments.

Bud Rue, one of the founding members of the Upper Delaware Universalist Fellowship, had a passion for helping social justice organizations with their mission to create just communities. He organized the first Walk for Social Justice in 1993 and in the midst of it suffered asthma and a heart attack and died. The walk has continued since then, although missed a few recent years, and is dedicated to Bud's name and the ideal that there is inherent worth and dignity in every individual and that it is imperative that we support those who work to bring this to fruition in our communities.
